Steak Plate Sale

- 1. 1,000.00 tickets distributed
- 2. 954 plates prepared (2 Plates were dropped at preparation)
- 3. 44 containers remained
- 4. 1,000 steaks ordered, however their math did not add up
- 5. A total of tickets were redeemed
- 6. Their formula 1,000 @ 7 ozs. per steak= 7,000 ozs. Divided by 16 ozs. = 437 lbs)
- Their butcher cut steaks until all meat was finished. This is why some of us did notice that some of those steaks were larger than others.
- 8. On the shortness of the rice, was due to over portioned
- 9. On the shortness of bread, it was a mis-calculation on the number of slices per loaf
- 10. 3 Knights have not turned in \$300.00 unaccounted and 60 plates not sold?
- 11. This balances the cash plates that were sold
- 12. Danny Salazar turned in 20 unsold , Jorge Gutierrez turned in 20 unsold, Carlos Galvan turned in 20 unsold, these 60 were sold at the church door
- 13. Alvaro Mendez, Eddie Perez, Jorge Rodriguez no monies nor tickets turned in

The council acquired 11 boxes of coats (total coats 132)

- 3 Boxes were donated by the council
- 8 Boxes were acquired through various community donations.

A total of \$1,926.52 was raised through donations.
